- 1-2 1st corners cast L (behind Nbrs) and change places.
 - 3-4 2nd corners cast R (behind Ptrs) and change places.
 - 5-6 With Ptr, go back-to-back.
 - 7-8 M1, moving L, draw the set out into a line of four facing up.

↑ M1 M2 W2 W1 ↑

- 1-2 Lines of four lead up, turn individually, and fall back.
 - 3-4 Lines of four lead down, turn individually, and fall back (hold the lines).
 - 5-6 End people gate the middle people around and back into major lines.
 - 7-8 CAST AND LEAD: 1st couple cast down, 2nd couple lead up.

This dance is named for a flower that was growing outside our window as I danced around the living room working out these figures. Rowena tells me that Summersweet is native to New England and is noted for its fragrance.
